

6. COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE - REPORT OF 19 MARCH 2003

The various outcomes from the Committee's 19 March meeting were considered and the Board **decided:**

6.1 COMMUNITY WORKER – BURNSIDE TRANSFORMATION TRUST/ST TIM'S

That the balance of the Board's existing funding support be carried forward into the 2003/04 period.

6.2 COMMUNITY FACILITIES REDEVELOPMENT – UPDATE

That the information be received.

6.3 GAMING MACHINE FUNDING

That the information be received.

6.4 COMMUNITY BOARD FUNDED YOUTH PROGRAMMES

That the information be received.

The Board asked that staff give consideration to extending these programmes into other areas of the Fendalton/Waimairi community currently not catered for.
