

## 9. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

### 9.1 John Wilson – Jubilee Street Extension Land and Access Issues

John Wilson addressed the Board regarding the Jubilee Street extension and land and access issues. Mr Wilson owns land at the corner of Jubilee and Bamford Streets. He expressed a desire to continue his current access over Council land off Bamford Street (near the corner with Jubilee Street) and also look at the possibility of gaining access from Jubilee Street at a later date. He mentioned that he has had considerable dealings with Council staff over access. The Community Advocate offered to meet with John and discuss this issue.

### 9.2 Ferrymead/Brookhaven Residents' Association Inc – Concerns

Des Snelling addressed the Board regarding a number of areas of concern.

The Board **decided**:

1. That Council staff be requested to carry out maintenance required to prevent flooding on Dyers Road.
2. That the speed limit on Dyers Road between Linwood Avenue and Ferry Road be considered within the current round of speed limit reviews.
3. That a bid for a footpath in Palinurus Road be submitted in the current budget round.
4. That the issue of bus stop locations be referred to the ECan/Council Joint Passenger Transport Committee and the Community Secretary write to ECan regarding the possibility of a shuttle service between Brookhaven and Eastgate Mall.

### 9.3 Councillor Sue Wells – Neighbourhood Week

Sue Wells addressed the Board regarding Neighbourhood Week and asked the Board to consider appointing a representative to the Joint Neighbourhood Week Committee.

### 9.4 Lisa Hadfield – Sumner Riding School

Lisa Hadfield presented 30 letters in support of her riding school at Sumnervale Reserve.

### 9.5 Frances Ryman – Heritage Lighting on Oxford Terrace

Frances Ryman and Nicholas Sibley addressed the Board regarding heritage lighting in Bangor Street. Mr Sibley offered to fund the undergrounding of wires and installation of heritage lights in Bangor Street.

The Board **decided**:

1. That its support for Mr Sibley's project be conveyed to the City Streets Manager.
2. That a project proposal be requested from the City Streets Unit for the Board's consideration, with this proposal including consultation with the community.
