

7. APPLICATIONS BY VODAFONE TO LOCATE MOBILE PHONE EQUIPMENT ON COUNCIL PROPERTY

The Committee **received** a report from Victoria Murdoch (Property Projects Officer) seeking the Committee's approval for Vodafone to install 14 micro sites and three macro sites within Christchurch. These approvals are required to enable Vodafone to proceed with their application for resource consent.

All sites had been reviewed by Council officers and were considered consistent with the Council's protocol/policy for cellular transmitting sites. The 14 micro sites required the Committee's approval in accordance with Step 12 of the cell sites protocol. In addition approvals were also sought for three macro sites.

The Committee **resolved**:

1. That the 13 micro facilities numbered 2-14 as outlined in the report to the Committee be approved in accordance with Step 12 of the cell sites protocol process.
2. That the micro facility on a street light pole situated on Beach Road, North New Brighton (no 1) not be approved pending further information being supplied to the Committee on that site.
3. That the three macro sites as outlined in the report and shown on Plans 13, 14 and photo 3 be approved so that Vodafone may proceed in accordance with the protocol, this includes the Telco arranging a public open information day in accordance with Step 16 of the process.
