

23. TE ORA HOU PERFORMING ARTS PROJECT

The Board considered a report from the Community Development Adviser seeking assistance with funding for the Te Ora Hou Performing Arts Project. The project helps to meet the Council's Arts Policy and Strategy. It also helps to meet the Board's Objectives "to promote a safe, healthy community" and that "the Treaty of Waitangi is honoured".

Board members questioned the breakdown of costs and drew the staff's attention to a discrepancy in the addition of the figures. Upon consideration of this the staff changed the amount of 'funds yet to be raised' from \$13,000 to \$9,500 and amended the staff recommendation to read:

As this project helps to meet the outcomes of the Strengthening Communities Action Plan (SCAP) then the recommendation is that a grant of \$5,000 be allocated from SCAP funds to Te Ora Hou towards expenses related to the Performing Arts Programme.

The Board **resolved** that a grant of \$5,000 be allocated from the 2002/03 SCAP Funds to Te Ora Hou for expenses related to the Performing Arts Programme.
