## 18. COMBINED COMMITTEE

The Board considered the report of its Combined Committee meeting held on 17 March 2003 and **resolved** to adopt the recommendations contained therein as follows:

## 18.1. Spreydon/Heathcote input to Artworks in Public Places plan

That the following opportunities be investigated:

- Te Kura Kaupapa School symbolic landscaping to represent Maori
- Arts trail along the Heathcote River (continuation of Farnley Reserve)
- Sydenham Mainstreet project (tree surrounds, seating)
- Some of the less affluent areas need something to give the area a lift (in a park or somewhere central)
- Seating/utilities along the Heathcote Riverbank
- Reference was made to the success of the Rowley community art project. It was suggested that buildings in the Sydenham shopping area could be painted different colours
- Sydenham area would be a good location for some functional art (eg bike stands)
- Artwork in volcanic stone south of the Moorhouse Avenue overhead bridge in Sydenham
- Two pieces of artwork could be brought back to the Board for consideration, to be located inside the new South Christchurch facility

## 18.2. Sydenham Mainstreet Project

- 1. That design work for new signage be investigated by some of the arts schools and be held as a competition in conjunction with Mayfest.
- 2. That existing garden plots be redesigned (in consultation with the Sydenham Network) with plants incorporating colour.
- 3. That planting along the Colombo Street frontage of Sydenham Park be carried out.
- 4. That staff and local businesses meet to discuss further options for expending funding allocated for the current financial year.
