2. SIGNIFICANT ISSUES FACING CHRISTCHURCH AND THE URBAN PLANNING AND GROWTH SPECIAL COMMITTEE'S ROLE

A report by the Strategy and Policy Team Leader outlined some of the key issues facing Christchurch regarding urban development, as well as the Committee's work load and work priorities for the next 12-18 months.

The Committee decided:

- 1. That the order of work priority be as follows:
 - (a) Commercial strategy,
 - (b) Area development plans and residential growth in Greenfield areas,
 - (c) Urban development strategy and the Long Term Council Community Plan (LTCCP),
 - (d) Cross boundary issues,
 - (e) Urban Renewal.
- 2. That a further report be brought to the next Committee meeting outlining a general work programme and reporting timeframe for consideration.
- 3. That a demonstration of 'webmap' be arranged for the Committee, as a means of demonstrating an overview of planning records being developed for the city.
