4. WAIMAIRI ROAD - PROPOSED CYCLE LANES

The Board was requested to recommend to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee that cycle lanes be installed in Waimairi Road between Tudor Avenue and Westburn School as detailed on the submitted plan.

Details of the feedback received from local residents were provided in the accompanying report.

Mention was made of the Board's long held concerns about the continued recognition of this section of Waimairi Road as part of the ring road network and the associated traffic management issues involving the Westburn School in particular.

The Board **decided** that it be recommended to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee that the proposals as shown on TP 153701, be approved for construction.

(Note: Pat Harrow asked that his vote be recorded against the decision for the reason that he did not support the Council's practice of painted cycleway lines being marked on collector, minor and major arterial roads on the grounds that he considered these were dangerous, especially for young cyclists.)
