

#### 4. WORKS, TRAFFIC AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE - REPORT OF 14 OCTOBER 2003



The Board considered the report and accompanying recommendations of the Committee's 14 October meeting and **decided**:

##### 4.1 WINCHESTER STREET – PROPOSED KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

1. That the proposed works in Winchester Street be approved for consultation.
2. That for reasons of uniformity, the same street trees be used as those planted in the completed section of Winchester Street.

##### 4.2 KERB AND CHANNEL PRIORITISATION PROGRAMME

That further consideration of the kerb and channel prioritisation programme be undertaken by the Works, Traffic and Environment Committee at its next meeting.

##### 4.3 CYCLEWAY NETWORK IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAMME – FENDALTON/WAIMAIRI WARDS

The Board noted that in receiving the information submitted, the Committee had asked that copies of the cycleway maps presented, be made available to Board members as a resource for future use.

##### 4.4 ROYDVALE AVENUE – TELECOM POLES

That the information be received and that Mr Peter Simmonds be informed that no further action could be taken, although Telecom would be written to urging some further consideration beyond the asset management aspect with a view to being a good corporate citizen.

##### 4.5 GENERAL

The Board noted the requested review of the under tree planting carried out along the Aikmans Road frontage of the Merivale Mall car park.
