## 7. REPORT OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE: 4 NOVEMBER 2003

The Board received the information contained in subclauses 16.3, 16.4, 16.6 and 16.7 of the report.

## **Proposed Changes to Speed Limits**

It was moved that the Board advise the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee that it does not support any increase in vehicle speed limits on Aldwins Road. The motion was declared **carried** on a division by four votes to two, the voting being as follows:

For (4):	Bob Todd, Linda Rutland, Yani Johanson and John Freeman.
Against (2):	Rod Cameron, David Cox

The Board also **decided** to advise the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee that it supported the lowering of vehicle speeds from 50 km/h to 40 km/h on the Esplanade in Sumner.

## Parking Strategy

The Board **decided** to recommend that in implementing actions 2 and 7 identified under New Management on page 32 of the Parking Strategy, that appropriate staff undertake those actions in relation to parking issues in the area around Jade Stadium and that a review of the Hagley Park Management Plan be undertaken as a priority.

## Leopard Coachlines Bus Depot: Compliance with City Plan

The Board **received** the information and **decided** that Council staff be requested to hold a meeting to brief Charleston residents on this issue.
