**1. CENTAURUS ROAD AND ST MARTINS ROAD (COLOMBO STREET TO GAMBLINS ROAD) –
KERB AND CHANNEL**

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval for acceptance of a tender which is above the \$500,000 authority delegated to Council Officers.

BACKGROUND

This project forms part of the City Streets Unit's capital expenditure programme for the 2003/04 year and is shown in the capital output of the financial plan and programme.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The contract is for the renewal of kerb and channel in Centaurus Road from Palatine Terrace to St Martins Road, carriageway reconstruction of St Martins Road from Centaurus Road to Koromiko Street and traffic management of Centaurus Road and St Martins Road from Colombo Street to Gamblins Road.

Tender prices have been received as follows:

BD Construction Limited	\$663,000.00
City Care Limited	\$683,384.35
Calcon Asphalt Limited	\$789,722.70
Local Construction Limited	\$823,905.00

This project is within the capital works budget.

All prices exclude GST.

These prices include a contingency sum of \$40,000 and the work is for a 25 week construction period. Completion date is 23 July 2004.

The estimate for the work was \$735,602.

RESULTS OF CONSULTATION

At their July 2003 meetings the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee and the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board approved this project for construction.

The standard roadworks information leaflet had been circulated inviting comments relating to the project and all enquiries and comments from residents and others have been satisfactorily resolved.

Martin Walker of BD Construction Limited has given an assurance that the work can be completed within the specified time.
