


#### 4. NEW PLAQUE – CITIZENS’ WAR MEMORIAL, CATHEDRAL SQUARE



A report from the Parks and Waterway area advocate detailed the proposal of Mr Earle Crutchley to install a plaque on the Citizens’ War Memorial (Cenotaph) in Cathedral Square to commemorate the involvement of the Merchant Navy in World Wars I and II.

The Committee **resolved**

1. That a plaque and memorial policy be addressed through the Council’s Art in Public Places policy.
2. That a small working party comprising the Committee Chair and Councillor Pat Harrow work with appropriate Council staff to consider the options of siting the Merchant Navy plaque in Cathedral Square and provide a suitable solution.
