12. STRUCTURE ON STREET APPLICATION – 143 TAYLORS MISTAKE ROAD

A report sought the approval of the Board for the construction of a timber access ramp and low retaining structures to serve 143 Taylors Mistake Road.

The Board **resolved** that the construction of the timber access ramp and low retaining structure be approved subject to the conditions 1 to 5 set out below:

- 1. A deed of licence being entered into with the Council.
- 2. Resource and building consents being obtained for the structures on road.
- 3. The engineering plan for the construction being approved by the City Streets Unit prior to construction.
- 4. The owner being required to maintain the site in a safe and tidy manner at all times at the time of construction.
- 5. The owner to be responsible for the future maintenance of the vehicles' access and associated structures.

13. STRUCTURE ON STREET APPLICATION – 159 TAYLORS MISTAKE ROAD

A report sought the approval of the Board for the construction of two retaining walls to serve 159 Taylors Mistake Road.

The Board **resolved** that the construction of two retaining walls be approved subject to the conditions 1 to 5 set out below.

- 1. A deed of licence being entered into with the Council.
- 2. Resource and building consents being obtained for the structures on road.
- 3. The engineering plan for the construction being approved by the City Streets Unit prior to the construction.
- 4. The owner being required to maintain the site in a safe and tidy manner at all times at the time of construction.
- 5. The owner being responsible for the future maintenance of the vehicles' access and associated structures.
