


5. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

5.1 SOUTH NEW BRIGHTON MOTOR CAMP



June Barns and Garry Gaynor, lessees of the South New Brighton Motor Camp, were in attendance to speak about their request for an extension to the term of the camp lease beyond 2011.

They expressed concern at the disruption and loss of the camp's character resulting from the loss of large numbers of trees through the storm in 2000 and recent felling by the Council for safety reasons. The potential disruption from the proposed wastewater ocean outfall pipeline also concerns them. In their view, the value of their investment in the camp is affected and an extension of the lease is needed to protect the investment while the camp's character is restored by replanting.

The Board's decision is recorded under Part A, clause 22 of this report.

5.2 HORSESHOE LAKE ROAD/BROOMFIELD TERRACE TRAFFIC ISSUES

Brian Soper from the Horseshoe Lake Residents' Group was in attendance to request roading improvements in Horseshoe Lake Road and additional parking in Broomfield Terrace. He supported the road shoulder and lighting improvements proposed in the officer's report on traffic management in the area, but did not support the proposal for three chicanes.
