

12. CORRESPONDENCE (Cont'd)

Further to clause 1 (Part B) of this report, the Board also made the resolutions set out below:

12.1 Proposed Alcohol Policy

The Board considered a letter from Klaus Prusas, Team Leader Environmental Effects, attaching the Council's draft alcohol policy.

The Board **resolved**:

1. That the draft alcohol policy be referred to the Community, Policy and Finance Committee with power to act to submit proposed amendments to the document.
2. That a report on the inner city alcohol ban be included in the Community, Policy and Finance Committee agenda for the meeting at which the draft alcohol policy is considered.
3. That the membership of the Community, Policy and Finance Committee be extended to include all Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board members for the purpose of submitting proposed amendments to the draft alcohol policy.

12.2 Keep Christchurch Beautiful Grant – Funding Purpose

The Board **resolved** to agree to the transfer of the residual funding for beach education funding purposes.

12.3 Guides New Zealand – Te Ropu Tamariki

The Board considered a letter from Guides New Zealand seeking \$8,000 funding for the eight Te Ropu Tamariki after school clubs situated in the Hagley and Ferrymead wards. Refer also to clause 9.3.

The Board **resolved**:

1. To allocate \$4,000 from its discretionary fund to Guides New Zealand for the Te Ropu Tamariki project.
2. To allocate a further \$1,000 from its discretionary fund to Guides New Zealand for the purpose of implementing/continuing Parenting with Confidence courses.
