



11. OWAKA LAND PURCHASE AND AWATEA VARIATION PROGRESS

There was some discussion on land adjoining the Owaka pit which was currently being offered for sale by the current owner.

Members were of the opinion that the land in question may have been included in a “green belt” proposal that the Waterways Unit had brought to the Board on a previous occasion.
