

8. VODAFONE CELL SITES

The Committee considered a report by the Property Manager, seeking approval for Vodafone to locate the following two macro telecommunication facilities on the Council's street assets:

1. **Linwood TCPLNW Chch – Intersection Aldwins Road and Linwood Avenue, Linwood**

This proposal is to replace the existing pole situated on the corner of Aldwins Road and Linwood Avenue with a 20 metre high pole. The traffic camera will be relocated at 10 metres in height with the telecommunications components above. The components required are:

- (a) 300mm diameter microwave antenna
- (b) Three flush mounted antennae panels each 340mm x 140mm x 3.0 m in size.

2. **Hagley Park Central TCPHYC – Intersection Deans Avenue and Riccarton Road, Riccarton, Christchurch**

This proposal is to install a 16 metre high pole at the intersection of Deans Avenue and Riccarton Road. Telecommunications components will be situated below the spotlights which light the roundabout. The components include three flush mounted antennae panels each 340mm x 140mm x 3.0m in size.

The applications are consistent with the Council's policy/protocol.

The Committee **resolved** that approval be granted for the installation of the two macro facilities proposed, at the foregoing locations.
