

17. CASHEL STREET CONSTRUCTION ZONE

The Committee considered a report from Barry Cook, Traffic Engineer – Community, City Streets Unit seeking approval for a “Construction Zone” to be installed on a temporary basis on the north side of Cashel Street, just west of Manchester Street.

The report noted that the Trader McKendrys Hotel on the north east corner of Manchester Street had now been demolished, and a new Shooters Hotel is being built on the site. It proposed that to allow for construction requirements and to minimise disruption to traffic, a “Construction Zone” be installed on the Cashel Street frontage in the area which is currently a “P5 Loading Zone”.

The Committee **resolved**:

1. That the “Loading Zone Time Limit 5 Minutes” on the north side of Cashel Street commencing at a point 11 metres from its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 8m be temporarily removed.
2. That a “Construction Zone Authorised Vehicles Only” be installed on the north side of Cashel Street commencing at a point 11 metres from its intersection at Manchester Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 8m.
3. That the “Loading Zone Time Limit 5 Minutes” be reinstated after the completion of the work.
