6. PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE DOG CONTROL ACT 1996

The Committee considered a report from Terence Moody (Environmental Health Policy Leader) and Mark Vincent (Team Leader Animal Control) on the proposed amendments to the Dog Control Act 1996 and the effects that these changes may have on dog control operations undertaken by this Council, and suggested matters on which submissions may be made.

The Committee resolved:

- 1. That the amended submissions be approved for sending to the Local Government and Environment Select Committee by 20 June 2003 with a request to be heard in regard to these.
- 2. That a supplementary report be prepared for the Council meeting on 26 June 2003 to seek the views of the Council in regard to charging for appeals to the Council against dangerous dog classifications.
