1. CITY PLAN VARIATION - CREATION OF THE CENTRAL CITY EDGE ZONE



The Committee considered a report by Andrew Willis (Planner) on the City Plan Variation - Creation of the Central City Edge Zone, which it had deferred for consideration at the reconvened meeting.

The purpose of the report was to request the Council to adopt a section 32 report and provisionally approve and publicly notify a variation to create a Central City Edge Zone covering three blocks and including the Turners and Growers site.

The Committee decided:

- 1. That the Regulatory and Consents Committee defer making a decision on the City Plan Variation Creation of the Central City Edge Zone report to allow for further discussion on the specifics of what the Variation is intended to achieve.
- 2. That an analysis of the following items be provided to a seminar meeting of the Regulatory and Consents Committee to be held on Thursday 3 July 2003 at 2pm:
 - (a) Clarification of what the Variation aims to achieve and what revitalisation is expected to achieve for the three block and one block areas.
 - (b) A comparison of the relative merits of the rezoning of the entire block versus the rezoning of the one block.
 - (c) An identification of issues contained within the current Variation proposal that are not covered within the parameters of the Council's resolution of September 2002.
 - (d) Identification of the changes that would be included in a Variation for:
 - The Turners and Growers site only, comprising part of the block bounded by Lichfield Street, Tuam Street, Madras Street and Barbadoes Street.
 - The Turners and Growers block, comprising the whole of the block bounded by Lichfield Street, Tuam Street, Madras Street and Barbadoes Street.
