11. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

1. Mairehau High School - Hills Road/Innes Road Intersection

Mr Neil Lancaster, Principal, Mairehau High School, Mr James Shand, Finance/Administration Manager and Ms Kendra Brownlee, student attended and spoke to the Committee about their concerns regarding the traffic flows around the School. A short PowerPoint presentation showing pictures of the areas of concern was presented to the Committee and it was noted that the roll at the school had increased over the last six years from 480 to 750 pupils with a current staff of 120.

The school was concerned that the development of a large subdivision in the area would further exacerbate traffic issues in this locality and requested that the Council provide traffic signals at this intersection, move the 80kph speed sign further back and provide yellow 'no parking' and central road line markings.

The representations from the school were considered in association was clause 14 of this report relating to the Hills Road/Innes Road intersection.
