## 19. LICHFIELD STREET P10 RESTRICTED PARKING

The Committee considered a report from Basil Pettigrew, Traffic Engineer – Community, City Streets Unit seeking approval for the installation of P10 restricted parking in Lichfield Street, east of Durham Street, in response to requests from local businesses to provide space for short term parking.

It noted that several rental car companies had premises located in the vicinity and detailed the relevance of the request to the proposed parking strategy.

## The Committee resolved:

- 1. That the three existing parking meters with a time limit of 60 minutes installed on the south side of Lichfield Street commencing at a point 77.5 metres from the eastern kerb line of Durham Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 17.3 metres be removed.
- 2. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 10 minutes on the southern side of Lichfield Street commencing at a point 77.5 metres from the eastern kerb line of Durham Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 17.3 metres.
- 3. That the two existing parking meters with a time limit of 60 minutes installed on the north side of Lichfield Street commencing at a point 28 metres from the eastern building line of No 19 Lichfield Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 12 metres be removed.
- 4. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 10 minutes on the northern side of Lichfield Street commencing at a point 28 metres from the eastern building line of No 10 Lichfield Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- 5. That the motorcycle park installed on the northern side of Lichfield Street commencing at a point 46.3 metres from the eastern building line of No 19 Lichfield Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 6.3 metres be removed.
- 6. That a parking meter with a time limit of 60 minutes be installed on the northern side of Lichfield Street commencing at a point 46.3 metres from the eastern building line of No 19 Lichfield Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 6.3 metres.
