

21. REPORT OF THE CYCLE STEERING GROUP

The Committee considered a report on the April 2003 meeting of the Cycle Steering Group which outlined the matters considered at that meeting together with the recommendations of the Steering Group in respect of:

- The provision of off-road cycleways where they can be installed.
- Support for the Living Streets concept and slowing of traffic in urban areas (including 30 kph zones) so that appropriate speeds are achieved.
- Treatment of arterial roads to provide the best transport solution in a shared environment.
- The provision of better storage facilities for cycles in shopping malls.

The Committee **resolved**:

1. That the Committee confirm its support for the cycle strategy.
2. That a representative of Environment Canterbury be appointed to the Cycle Steering Group.
