### 2. ALLOCATION OF PROJECT AND DISCRETIONARY FUNDING 2003/04

A report from the Community Secretary identified projects forwarded to the Board for consideration from the 2003/04 Project and Discretionary funding.

#### The Board resolved:

- 1. That the Board allocations be confirmed subject to consideration of any key items programmed for 2003/04 that may be deleted from the Council's Annual Plan during the budget review process later this month.
- 2. That the Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and Community Advocate be delegated the authority of the Board to reallocate any funds to approved projects where this is considered to be absolutely necessary, due to deletions from the 2003/04 programme.
- 3. That the balance of unallocated funds up to \$60,000 be retained for Board allocation during 2003/04.
- 4. That at a May Board meeting the Board consider bringing forward certain projects from this agenda for funding from 2002/03 Discretionary funding and any funds made available be added to Discretionary funding for 2003/04.
- 5. That items of Project funding approved by the Board be designated for projects under the Strengthening Communities Action Plan funding by the Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and the Community Advocate.
