


3. BARNETT PARK – TOILET BLOCK DEMOLITION



The Board considered a report seeking a recommendation to the Council by way of the Parks, Gardens and Waterways Committee, that the toilet block situated at the front of Barnett Park be demolished to enable construction of the proposed new crèche building.

The Board **decided** to support the proposal subject to the following recommendation being placed before the Parks, Gardens and Waterways Committee:

- (a) Public consultation being undertaken with affected parties about the proposed demolition of the toilet block as part of the joint public advertising of the proposed change of classification, and notified resource consent process and the Board being kept informed on feedback from affected parties in respect of the proposed demolition.
- (b) The write-off occurring in the 2002/03 financial year from the proposed Parks and Waterways Unit budget.
- (c) That if as a result of the advertising/consultation process referred to above, the public requests replacement toilets, then appropriate provision be made in the capital works programme.
