8. WILLIAM GUISE BRITTAN RESERVE - PLANTING ISSUES, LAND AROUND THE RESERVE

The Committee considered a report on improvements to the intersection of Kilmore Street, Avonside Drive, Fitzgerald Avenue and Oxford Terrace including river banks. The report outlined work carried out to date, and proposed, for this planting season.

The Committee decided:

- 1. That the information be received and the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board be invited to support financially the purchase and planting of King Alfred daffodil bulbs in the Fitzgerald Avenue median.
- 2. That the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board be invited to consider installing a bollard with a bronze plaque identifying the William Guise Brittan wharf. Mrs Frances Ryman (historian) could assist with appropriate text.
