14. NORTHLANDS REDEVELOPMENT: ASSOCIATED TRAFFIC MEASURES (MAIN NORTH ROAD AND SAWYERS ARMS ROAD)

The Board considered a report from the City Streets Manager seeking comment on a revised traffic management scheme for Main North Road and Sawyers Arms Road to be recommended to the Council through the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee.

The Chairperson invited Mr Mike Gadd to address the Board. Mr Gadd indicated that he was grateful for the amendments which had been made but was disappointed that the bus stop had not been moved and the lack of a median.

The Chairperson informed the Board on behalf of Corina Duke of the Royal NZ Foundation for the Blind, of some changes the Foundation would like to see included in the plan.

The Board decided to recommend to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee:

- 1. That the recommended plan for Main North Road and Sawyers Arms Road be approved for construction.
- 2. That the changes sought by the Royal NZ Foundation for the Blind be taken into account in the Council's plan.
