

9. CONFIRMATION OF REPORT TO COUNCIL: 1 APRIL 2003

It was **resolved** that the report to Council of the meeting of 1 April 2003 be confirmed as a true and accurate record of that meeting.

Matters Arising

Domain Terrace – Neighbourhood Improvement Works

The Chairperson advised that he wished to raise the matter of Domain Terrace, as a number of residents from Edinburgh Street had raised concerns regarding the works approved for Domain Terrace. The Board had been unaware of these concerns at the time approval was granted. The residents of Edinburgh Street believed that motorists would avoid Domain Terrace and cut through Edinburgh Street once the chicane was installed. Edinburgh Street residents were also concerned that the consultation document was not circulated widely enough in Edinburgh Street.

Following discussion City Streets staff agreed that a letter could be distributed to residents in Edinburgh Street between Domain Terrace and Lyttelton Street.

The Board **decided** that a letter be delivered to all residents in Edinburgh Street between Domain Terrace and Lyttelton Street, explaining the works which are proposed and the consultation process previously undertaken, and advising that, should sufficient concerns be raised by residents, a further report will be submitted to the Board before any work commences.
