


11. LIVING TOGETHER SEMINAR



The Committee considered a report from the Chairman on the 'Living Together Seminar' held on Thursday 1 May 2003 and which was attended by some members of the Committee.

The report noted two of the possible actions which emerged from the seminar which related to the establishment of neighbourhood sustainability groups, based on neighbourhood support groups and the United Nations Car Less Day. The Chairman reminded members that he had previously attended a conference in Freemantle on the United Nations Car Less Day.

- Recommendation:**
1. That Christchurch City Council sustainability staff be requested to investigate (with Environment Canterbury) the establishment of neighbourhood sustainability groups in Christchurch, with the purpose of policy establishment and funding provision through the Strategy and Finance Committee.
 2. That the City Streets Manager be requested to investigate a proposal (with Environment Canterbury) for a Car Less Day event in Christchurch during 2004/05.
