

12. GLOUCESTER STREET/LINWOOD AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNALS

The Board considered a report outlining the actions to be taken to improve traffic management at the Gloucester Street/Linwood Avenue intersection.

The Board **received** the information and **resolved**:

1. To support the traffic management proposals for the section of Linwood Avenue between Gloucester Street and Hereford Street.
2. That a “zebra” pedestrian crossing be installed within the left turn slip lane from Linwood Avenue into Gloucester Street west, linking with the existing pedestrian/splitter traffic island and the footpath on the south west corner of the intersection outside number 136 Linwood Avenue.
3. That the traffic management proposals for the section of Linwood Avenue between Gloucester Street and Hereford Street be reviewed after six months have passed.
