13. INNES ROAD – PROPOSED KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The Board considered a report seeking its comments on a report to be submitted to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee regarding the proposed renewal of the kerb and channel in Innes Road, between Cranford Street and Jamieson Avenue.

The Board **decided** to submit the following recommendations to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee, subject to satisfactory communication between the City Streets Consultation Leader, Brian Boddy, and Martin Meehan, on behalf of the local businesses.

- 1. That approval be granted for the required construction work to proceed, in accordance with plan TP 152701.
- 2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the south-east side of Innes Road commencing at the eastern boundary of number 296 and extending in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 113 metres.
- 3. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the north-west side of Innes Road commencing at a point six metres west of the common boundary of numbers 231/233 and extending in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 113 metres.
