

15. NAYLAND STREET PEDESTRIAN ISLAND AND VILLAGE ENTRANCEWAYS AT REDCLIFFS AND SUMNER

The Board considered a report seeking its approval to consult on proposals for a pedestrian island in Nayland Street, an entranceway treatment on Main Road at Redcliffs and an entranceway treatment on Marriner Street at Sumner.

The Board **resolved**:

1. That the concept plans for the Nayland Street pedestrian refuge, Redcliffs Village entranceway (town/western approach) and Sumner Village entranceway (town/western approach) be distributed for community consultation.
2. That the Board consider making a submission for funding for entranceways on the eastern approaches to the Redcliffs and Sumner Villages through the capital works programme.
