## 2. CORRESPONDENCE

## 2.1 SUBMISSION TO LOOKING AHEAD 2003-2011

A letter was received from Wayne Thomas, Environment Canterbury, regarding the Board's submission to Environment Canterbury's draft annual plan 'Looking Ahead 2003-2011'. The Board **decided**:

- 1. That the information be received.
- 2. That the Board thank Environment Canterbury for its consideration of the Board's submission on 'Looking Ahead 2003-2011' and request: prioritisation be given to the Christchurch coastal area in work on the Canterbury coastal hazards zones; further information be provided on the timing of development of a network of cross-suburban bus routes to complement the Orbiter; and further consideration be given to the inclusion of beggar's tick in intensive weed management strategies.

## 2.2 NORTH NEW BRIGHTON COMMUNITY CENTRE

A letter was received from Kim Money, Community Connection Nga Ngaru Trust, regarding the Trust's proposal for a community café, youth venue, boutique movie theatre, healthy school lunch project and information centre at the North New Brighton Community Centre. The Board **decided**:
