8. PARKLANDS/QUEENSPARK YOUTH RECREATION NEEDS

A community and staff working party updated the Board on progress in clarifying and addressing the identified youth recreation needs in Parklands/Queenspark and sought approval for proposed uses of Board Project funding allocated in 2003/04 to Parklands community projects. The Board **resolved**:

- 1. That the 2003/04 Board Project funding of \$10,000 allocated to Parklands/Queenspark Community Projects be made available to achieve community youth aspirations through:
 - Providing ongoing special events to youth in the Parklands/Queenspark area.
 - Developing regular programmes for youth utilising the Parklands Community Centre and other facilities in Parklands/Queenspark.
 - Establishing a youth committee in Parklands/Queenspark.
- 2. That the funding allocation be expended under the joint discretion of the Community Recreation Adviser, Community Development Adviser, Community Advocate and Carmen Hammond.
- 3. That the Parklands/Queenspark youth working party continue to liaise with the library team in the development of youth programmes and youth-friendly facilities for the new Parklands Library.
- 4. That the Parklands/Queenspark youth working party be asked to invite Carmen Hammond to participate.
