

6. CLYDE ROAD KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Following an on-site meeting on Friday 29 August 2003 this matter was given further consideration.

Whilst the City Streets Unit is seeking approval to put the proposal out for community consultation, the Board's Transport and Roothing Committee has been in discussions with some residents of Clyde Road to work through some of their issues relating to the bridge over the Avon stream. These issues related to safety and site distances.

The Board discussed the outcomes of the on-site meeting and the suggested modifications sought by the Board.

The Board **resolved** that the City Streets Unit be requested to provide a new draft consultation plan for this work, which shows the removal of the fences on the eastern side of the Avon stream bridge and the footpath width improvements identified on the western side.

The Board also **resolved** that the Transport and Roothing Committee be delegated power to approve the revised plan for public consultation at its meeting on 12 September 2003.
