


4. MEETING WITH TRANSIT NZ AND TRANSFUND REPRESENTATIVES



There was discussion on the Transit New Zealand capital work programme in respect of the delay of major works in the Canterbury region, and the need to continue to lobby these organisations to seek a review of those decisions.

The delaying of the southern arterial and the need to address a western by-pass have major impact on the progress and planning of the wider city, and members felt that a meeting of all interested parties should be facilitated.

As well as Members of Parliament being invited, invitations could also be extended to Councillors, Ngai Tahu and other community leaders.

It was **agreed** that the Board pursue the facilitating of such a meeting.
