- CONSENT SOUGHT:** Land use consent
- PROPOSAL:** To utilise the existing former church building on the site as a community library facility with associated café, car parking and new landscaping. The existing building will be modernised to suit its new function. The proposed library will have a total floorspace of 400m², offering a variety of information, events and resources for the local community. The maximum hours of operation will be 8.30am – 10.30pm Monday to Saturday, and 9.30am – 5pm on Sundays. Four staff are to be employed in the library and up to three staff in the café. 18 parking spaces are to be provided on the site. The application includes an assessment of environmental effects.
