

ARTIST SOUGHT FOR ADDINGTON SCULPTURE

Artists interested in designing and constructing a sculpture for the reserve, on the corner of Lyttelton St and Lincoln Rd, are invited to register their interest with the Christchurch City Council.

It is thought the artwork could depict the historical significance of the site/surrounding area. Features to consider include:-

- it is important to Maori. It was a mahinga kai area (place to gather food) and well known for the mokihi (special canoe).
- was occupied by Nairns Nursery
- is close to the Addington Raceway and Showgrounds
- was once part of the Waimakariri River
- was once a car yard site

To register their interest, artists should submit a portfolio of their work to Arts Advisor Paula Rigby, C/- Christchurch City Council, P.O.Box 237, Christchurch.
