

PROPOSED TEMPORARY EASEMENTS - BOTANIC GARDENS

The Christchurch City Council has conditionally passed a resolution the intent of which is to give effect to the following action.

Pursuant to Section 48 (1), (a), of the Reserves Act 1977, to grant temporary easements over two separate sites on Botanic Gardens land for a period of two and a half years, in favour of the Canterbury Museum for construction/storage sites during redevelopment of the Museum. The easements relate to the Botanic Gardens land described in Schedule A.

The easements are to facilitate the 34 million dollar re-development of the Canterbury Museum, as there is insufficient vacant land within the Canterbury Museum's land title to accommodate the construction/storage sites necessary to undertake this contract.

SCHEDULE A

1. Approximately 240 square metres of Part Reserve 25 of 21.1374 hectares on SO Plan 11870, vested in the Christchurch City Council as a Local Purpose (Botanic Gardens) Reserve. This area of the Botanic Gardens is situated on the Rolleston Avenue frontage between the Canterbury Museum and Rolleston Avenue.
2. Approximately 850 square metres of Part Reserve 25 of 21.1347 hectares on SO Plan 11870, vested in the Christchurch City Council as a Local Purpose (Botanic Gardens) Reserve. This area of the Botanic Gardens is situated to the south, and southwest of the Canterbury Museum.
