

SEA LETTUCE REMOVAL TRIALS AVON-HEATHCOTE ESTUARY (IHUTAI)

- In terms of resource consent no. CRCo2o988 granted by Environment Canterbury to Christchurch City Council on 15 July 2002 for the purpose of carrying out sea lettuce and gracilaria removal trials on the foreshore and bed of the Estuary
- The Christchurch City Council notifies its intention to carry out the following small-scale removal operations during the period 12 November 2003 to 30 April 2004:

NATURE OF OPERATION

Temporary timber fences staked to the Estuary bed, projecting no more than 25 metres into the Estuary (measured perpendicular to the shore)
Tracked excavator operating from the top of the seawall and/or the bed of the estuary adjacent to the seawall.
