## CHRISTCHURCH PROPOSED CITY PLAN PROPOSED VARIATION NO. 87 CLARIFICATION OF TERMS RELATING TO “FOCAL POINTS”

The Christchurch City Council has prepared Variation No. 87 – Clarification of Terms Relating to “Focal Points”, to the Proposed Christchurch City Plan.

The purpose of Variation 87 is to remove inconsistencies by clarifying terms in the Proposed City Plan relating to the words ‘focal points’. The amendments are not intended to change the meaning of the individual subject provisions, nor have any regulatory impact. The Plan refers to community focal points, suburban focal points, visual and physical focal points and focal points for social interaction. The Variation amends and clarifies the way in which the term ‘focal points’ is used or replaces it with a term better describing its meaning.

The Variation and Assessment are available for inspection during normal opening hours at any of the Council’s Service Centre offices. For details of your nearest Service Centre, please telephone 941 8999.

Any person may make a submission on this Variation. Submissions must be in writing and in the prescribed form (Form 5) in the Resource Management (Forms) Regulations 1991 or similar. Forms are available from the Council Offices listed above.

Once all submissions have been received, they will be available for public inspection. There will then be an opportunity for anyone to make a submission in support of or in opposition to any of these submissions. A Council hearing will then be arranged to consider all submissions and decisions will be made.

**Note:** *From the date of public notification of the Variation the Proposed Plan shall have effect as if it had been so varied.*

The closing date for submissions is **Friday, 16 January 2004, at Civic Offices and any other Council Office before 5.00pm.**
