PROPOSAL: To establish and operate offices for the Maxim Institute in the existing building on the site. The activity will have a maximum of 8 staff and will operate between the hours of 8:30am and 5:00pm, Monday to Friday. Eight car parking spaces will be provided at the rear of the site and the applicant anticipates a maximum of 30 vehicle movements per day (including those to and from the site).
