| 3. Summit Road from the Orongmai Scenic Reserve extending for a distance of approximately 8 kilometres from the Sign of the Kiwi to Gebbies Pass. | Between 8.45am and 12.15pm on Sunday 21 March 2004 |

Right of Objection

These closures are proposed to be made under paragraph 11(e) of the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974 and will apply to all vehicular traffic with the exception of emergency service vehicles.
