**SYDENHAM PARK PROPOSED
LEASE – SYDENHAM RUGBY
FOOTBALL CLUB**

The Council has conditionally approved an application by the Sydenham Rugby Football Club Incorporated to convert the former South Christchurch Tennis Club pavilion on Sydenham Park to a changing facility. In addition to rugby, the Park caters for cricket, bowls and tennis and there is presently inadequate changing facilities on the Park to meet the needs of sport played on the Park. The Rugby Club which has a long association with Sydenham Park has purchased the former tennis pavilion which it intends to alter to six new changing rooms.

This is public notice that the Council, pursuant to Section 54 (1) (b) of the Reserves Act 1977, intends to grant the Sydenham Rugby Football Club Incorporated, a lease of approximately 218 square metres of part Rural Section 41338 being the footprint of the building. The proposed lease will be for a maximum term of 20 years less one day.
