

PROPOSED STOPPING OF WORCESTER STREET THROUGH LATIMER SQUARE

An extraordinary meeting of the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee was held at 1pm on Monday 18 August 2003, to consider a report recommending that the Council commence the procedure set out in the Local Government Act 1974 to formally stop the section of Worcester Street running through Latimer Square.

The Committee resolved to submit the following recommendation to the ordinary meeting of the Council to be held at 2pm on Thursday 28 August 2003:

1. That pursuant to Section 342(1)(a) of the Local Government Act 1974, and in the manner provided in the Tenth Schedule of this Act, the Christchurch City Council resolve to publicly notify the proposal to stop the road as shown on the plan of the proposal and described in the schedule contained in the report submitted to the meeting.
2. That pursuant to Section 345(1)(b) of the Local Government Act 1974 the Council affirm its intention to commence the process under the provisions of Section 14 of the Reserves Act 1977 (subject to the road being successfully stopped), to declare the land (Section 1 SO 323707) to be recreation reserve.

This resolution is publicly notified to comply with the requirements of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987, which require the public notification of resolutions adopted at extraordinary meetings.
