PROPOSAL: A retrospective resource consent to operate an office from a residentially zoned site. The office operates 8.30am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday and between 10.00am and 5.00pm on Saturday and Sunday. The office employes one full time staff member and four part time staff.

- 2. ADDRESS:** Part of St George's Hospital at 249 Papanui Road (Lot 1 DP 60620, Pt RS 133, Lot 1 DP 8769, Lot 1 DP 1899, Lot 2 DP 1899; 144-146 Heaton Street (Lot 1 DP 11807); and Existing St George's Hospital entrance (Lot 2 DP 11807).
PROPOSAL: To close an existing access and vehicle crossing on Heaton Street and establish a new access and vehicle crossing with a 5 metre wide entry and a 5.5 metre wide exit at 144-146 Heaton Street (after the removal of a dwelling house for which no resource consent is required). To use land for car parking on that part of the St George's Hospital site currently used for access to Heaton Street. To erect two 6 square metre pedestrian shelters on the same site as a Group 4 heritage building at the street frontage on either side of the proposed Heaton Street access. To establish new landscaping, car parking, and vehicle access on part of the St George's Hospital site in an area north of the existing St George's Hospital building and the Ward and Clinical Services building (currently under construction).
