- 1. ADDRESS:** Richmond Hill Waterway (between 12 Richmond Hill Road and the intersection with Nayland Street)

PROPOSAL: Diversion and naturalisation of a short section of the existing Richmond Hill Waterway in order to address stormwater disposal from the Richmond Hill area. The waterway will be diverted into the Richmond Hill road reserve, and restored to a natural state through re-grading and revegetation works. The proposal will involve narrowing Richmond Hill Road at this location, and the removal and replacement of 15 existing plane trees. The section of the waterway affected lies between 12 Richmond Hill Road (Lot 9 DP 3057) and the intersection of Nayland Street and Richmond Hill Road (adjacent to Lot 5 DP 3057).
