

PROPOSAL TO VARY PEDESTRIAN MALL STATUS – NEW BRIGHTON MALL

The Christchurch City Council, at an ordinary meeting held in the Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, Christchurch, at 2.00pm on Thursday 23 August 2001, adopted the following resolution providing for the variation of the pedestrian mall status of part of New Brighton Mall:

“That pursuant to section 336 of the Local Government Act 1974, the Christchurch City Council resolves by Special Order that the Special Order dated 20 February 1978 establishing the Brighton Mall be varied by deleting from the 1978 Special Order:

- (a) Seaview Road, between Union Street and Oram Avenue intersections; and*
- (b) Oram Avenue, between Seaview Road and Beresford Street intersections.”*

The resolution confirming the variation of the Special Order will be submitted to an ordinary meeting of the Council to be held in the Council Chamber, Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, starting at 12 noon on Thursday 27 September 2001, for confirmation by way of Special Order.
