MIDDLETON PARK PROPOSED TELSTRA SATURN CABLE EASEMENT

The Council has conditionally approved the grant of an easement to Telstra Saturn Limited over part of Middleton Park for the purpose of laying an underground fibre optic cable and erecting two surface equipment cabinets. It is proposed to locate the cable ducts and cabinets along the western boundary of Middleton Park adjacent the carpark off Lochee Road. The Council holds Middleton Park as a recreation reserve under the provisions of the Reserves Act 1977. The consent of the Minister of Conservation is required to the proposed easement.

This is public notice pursuant to Section 48 (2) of the Reserves Act 1977 that the Council intends to grant a cable easement over part Reserve 5144, of approximately 1 metre wide by 11 metres long in favour of Telstra Saturn
