**1. ADDRESS:** 100 Fendalton Road (Jenny Burt Florist's site on the corner of Fendalton Road and Stratford Street)

**PROPOSAL:** To continue with the existing florist use on site and to establish and operate a deli and café in the remaining area of the building on site. The florist, deli and café will be open from Monday to Sunday, 8:30 am to 5:30 pm. Seating will be provided for a maximum number of 24 patrons and this will include outdoor dining consisting of three tables with seating for 10 persons. The site is also proposed to be used for community meetings for a maximum number of 15 persons on up to three occasions per month with no more than one per week between the hours of 5:30 pm and 9:30 pm. There are currently two staff for the florist and there will be three additional staff on site for the deli and café. There is no onsite car-parking proposed. There is an existing sign of 0.8 m<sup>2</sup> and it is proposed to erect a further 0.7 m<sup>2</sup> of signage.
