

# **MAKING OF CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL TRAFFIC AND PARKING ALTERATION (NO 2) BYLAW 2001**

The Christchurch City Council, at an ordinary meeting held in the Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, Christchurch at 2.00pm on Thursday 23 August 2001, passed the following resolution:

*"That in pursuance of the powers vested in it by the Local Government Act 1974 and the Transport Act 1962, the Christchurch City Council makes the Christchurch City Traffic and Parking Alteration (No 2) Bylaw 2001."*

The principal purpose of the bylaw is to:

- Remove the prohibition on motor vehicles greater than 9m in length (such length including any trailer or semi-trailer) travelling in a northerly direction along Halswell Junction Road between Formans Road and Waterloo Road.

The bylaw is proposed to come into operation on 8 October 2001.

# **MAKING OF CHRISTCHURCH CITY WATER RELATED SERVICES BYLAW 2001**

The Christchurch City Council, at an ordinary meeting held in the Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, Christchurch at 2pm on Thursday 23 August 2001, passed the following resolution:

*"That in pursuance of the powers vested in it by the Local Government Act 1974 and the Health Act 1956, the Christchurch City Council makes the Christchurch City Water Related Services Bylaw 2001".*

The principal purpose of the bylaw is to:

- Regulate the public water supply service, stormwater drainage, private drainage and water supplies within the City of Christchurch. The proposed Bylaw is substantially the same as the Christchurch City Water Related Services Bylaw 1992, which will be revoked.

The bylaw is proposed to come into operation on 8 October 2001.
